
MTSS

MTSS (Multi-Tiered System of Supports) is a framework referenced nationwide with consistent major features, but nuanced differences from state-to-state or context-to-context. It is a school improvement framework for schools and districts to meet the academic, behavior, and social-emotional needs of **all** students. With a commitment to high and equitable outcomes for **all** students, the MTSS framework guides schools and districts in addressing:

- Evidence-based **Practices** that support students across all the tiers.
- Systems sustained by leadership to support educators.
- Continual use of **Data** to make decisions in the best interest of students, educators, families, and the community.

SYSTEMS OF SUPPORT

The Systems of Support Team (SoS), a team of five dedicated individuals, works to help districts implement strong Multi-Tiered Systems of Support in RI. To accomplish this, they created BRIDGE-RI, a tool aimed to increase school and district implementation of MTSS and evidence-based practices with fidelity by providing resources and effective learning opportunities for educators. BRIDGE-RI professional development offerings aims to strengthen collaboration, communication, and leadership to promote equitable outcomes.



WHAT IS IN MTSS RHODE ISLAND (MTSS-RI)?

MTSS-RI is Rhode Island's version of a MTSS, customized to incorporate state regulations, statutes, and initiatives to support common language across RI.

Through MTSS-RI, educators can expect to learn about:

- Improving academic, behavioral, and/or social-emotional outcomes for students
- Identifying and implementing evidence-based practices across the tiers of support, including universal core instruction and curriculum as well as targeted and intensive interventions
- Building the capacity of leaders and teams to support educators
- Using data to make decisions about core curriculum and instruction as well as intervention efficacy and movement into and out of interventions as needed

WHAT IS BRIDGE-RI?



BRIDGE-RI is the Moodle powered learning management system (LMS) used by MTSS-RI to engage a variety of educational stakeholders in free online and blended learning professional learning. Learning opportunities through BRIDGE-RI are designed to increase knowledge and application of MTSS-related topics. Additionally, BRIDGE-RI is an approved provider of professional learning through RIDE's Professional Learning Resource Network. Those who complete courses on BRIDGE-RI are able to submit their certificates for Professional Learning Units (PLUs).





WHAT DO WE OFFER

BRIDGE-RI offers free professional learning at **no cost**. To enroll in online professional learning, a user must create an account with BRIDGE-RI. It's free and easy to do so,

Professional learning through BRIDGE-RI is centered around one consistent framework - MTSS.

- Courses are organized by tier of support
- Any practices shared are evidence-based
- Equity and diversity implications are woven into all coursework
- The use of data to guide decision-making is explicitly outlined for each tier of support

There are three types of courses available on BRIDGE-RI:

COURSE TYPES

Self-paced courses are asynchronous and shorter in length, typically 1-2 hours, and are designed to be completed asynchronously. Participants can enroll at any time and can complete all coursework at their own pace.


Facilitated courses are longer and held over a period of time, e.g., September-December 2024. Participants will engage in both asynchronous coursework as well as synchronous checkins with course facilitators. There are typically assignments and deadlines with set dates for enrollment.

Communities of Practice are opportunities for participants to come together in real time to learn together, problem solve, and collaborate on a particular topic (or topics).
